

Training for Industry



The STA provides independent and impartial training on a variety of topics related to emissions monitoring.

The STA has developed a series of revision training courses based on the syllabuses for the MCERTS personnel competency standard. The courses are one day duration, and are held at the STA's Hitchin office starting at 10.00 and finishing at approximately 16.00.

The revision courses are designed to highlight the depth of knowledge required to succeed in the examinations. Current courses include:

Level 1 Technician

Course content:

- L1.1 Introduction to pollutants
- L1.2 Overview of legislation and monitoring guidance
- L1.3 Health & Safety requirements
- L1.4 Units and reference conditions
- L1.5 Equipment
- L1.6 Principles of stack-emission monitoring
- L1.7 Process conditions

Courses are run for a minimum of 5 delegates with a maximum of 10 delegates. The duration of each course is one day.



Who should attend

Revision courses are aimed at experienced stack emissions monitoring personnel who intend to apply for certification or recertification.
