

# Training for Industry



## MCERTS Personnel Competency Standard

The STA provides independent and impartial training to meet the needs of the members on a variety of topics related to emission monitoring.

The STA has developed a series of revision training courses based on the syllabuses for the MCERTS personnel competency standard. The courses are one day based at the Hitchin office starting 9.30 and finishing approx 17.00.

The revision courses are designed to highlight the depth of knowledge the candidates are required to know to enter for the examinations. Current courses include;

- Level 1** Technician
- Level 2** Team leader
- TE 1** Particulate measurement
- TE 2** Trace element (dioxins, metals etc) measurement
- TE 3** Gaseous measurement by manual extractive measurement
- TE 4** Gaseous measurement by instrumental analysers



Courses are based on a minimum of 5 delegates with a maximum of approximately 8—10 delegates.

Duration of each course is one day.

### Who should attend

These revision courses are aimed primarily at experienced personnel involved in stack emission monitoring who are planning on applying for certification or recertification.
