The revision courses are designed to highlight the depth of knowledge the candidates are required to have to take the examinations.

Level 2 Team Leader

Course Content

- L2.1 Monitoring standards and methods
- L2.2 Reference conditions
- L2.3 Analytical techniques and limits of detection
- L2.4 Abatement systems and their effects on monitoring
- L2.5 Choice of sampling location
- L2.6 Carrying out a measurement campaign
- L2.7 Health and safety requirements
- L2.8 Choice of sampling method, technique and equipment
- L2.9 Types of process operation and process details
- L2.10 Developing site-specific protocols
- L2.11 Principles of calculating uncertainty
- L2.12 Quality assurance

Courses are held online from 09.30 via Microsoft Teams. Duration of the Level 2 course is two days.

This course is for personnel who are at level 1 and are training to become a level 2 team leader.
